Firearms Safety and Field Procedures

- ___ 1. Rifle/Pistol Range procedures and gun safety requirements.
- ___ 2. Trap Field(s) procedures and gun safety requirements.
- ___ 3. Skeet Field procedures and gun safety requirements.

Club Opening Procedures

- ___ 1. Opening the front door (using assigned code). Sign in on the Log Sheet on the wall next to the kitchen.
- ___ 2. Same code is used to open the door to access the tally sheets, cash box, and field key and plastic envelopes for the day's receipts.
- ___ 3. Circuit box is located on the wall at the back of the club. Need to turn on the breakers for the trap and skeet fields.
- ___ 4. Turn on field lights, if necessary. (Two switches located in the small room next to the circuit board).
- ___ 5. Skeet field cord is on the wall near the large windows. Open the skeet field houses and turn on the machines. Ensure enough targets are loaded in the machine. Plug in the skeet cord in the center of the field.
- ___ 6. Open trap house. Set up activation speakers. Turn on machine(s). Be sure the supply of targets is adequate.
- ___ 7. Turn on the water pump. Turn on hot water heater ONLY if needed to wash dishes.
- ___ 8. Turn on Coffee maker, and brew coffee.
- ___ 9. Prepare sign up sheets for trap and skeet squads.
- ___ 10. Weather permitting, put out the flag.

Club Closing Procedures

- ___ 1. Turn off skeet and trap machines in respective houses. Release in target arms. Bring empty target boxes to the Clubhouse for dismantling.
- ___ 2. Disconnect, loosely wrap up skeet cord and bring in to the clubhouse.
- ___ 3. Disconnect and place trap speakers and activator box to the trap house.
- ___ 4. Make sure the skeet and trap house doors are locked and the key is returned to the cash box.
- ___ 5. Turn off skeet and trap circuit breakers, field lights (if on).
- ___ 6. Turn off switches for the water pump and hot water heater (if on).
- ___ 7. Turn off the coffee maker. Make sure the oven and stove burners are off.
- ___ 8. Complete the shoot dally sheet. Confirm it balances with cash in the box. Place cash and tally sheet in a plastic envelope and place in the top slot of the strong box on the floor of the locker area.
- ___ 9. Clean up the Clubhouse. Empty garbage cans and replace bags. Take garbage, including the empty target boxes to the dumpster.
- ___ 10. Put flag away, shut off all lights, lock windows and front door (with key or code).
